## Why Information Systems (at UoC)?

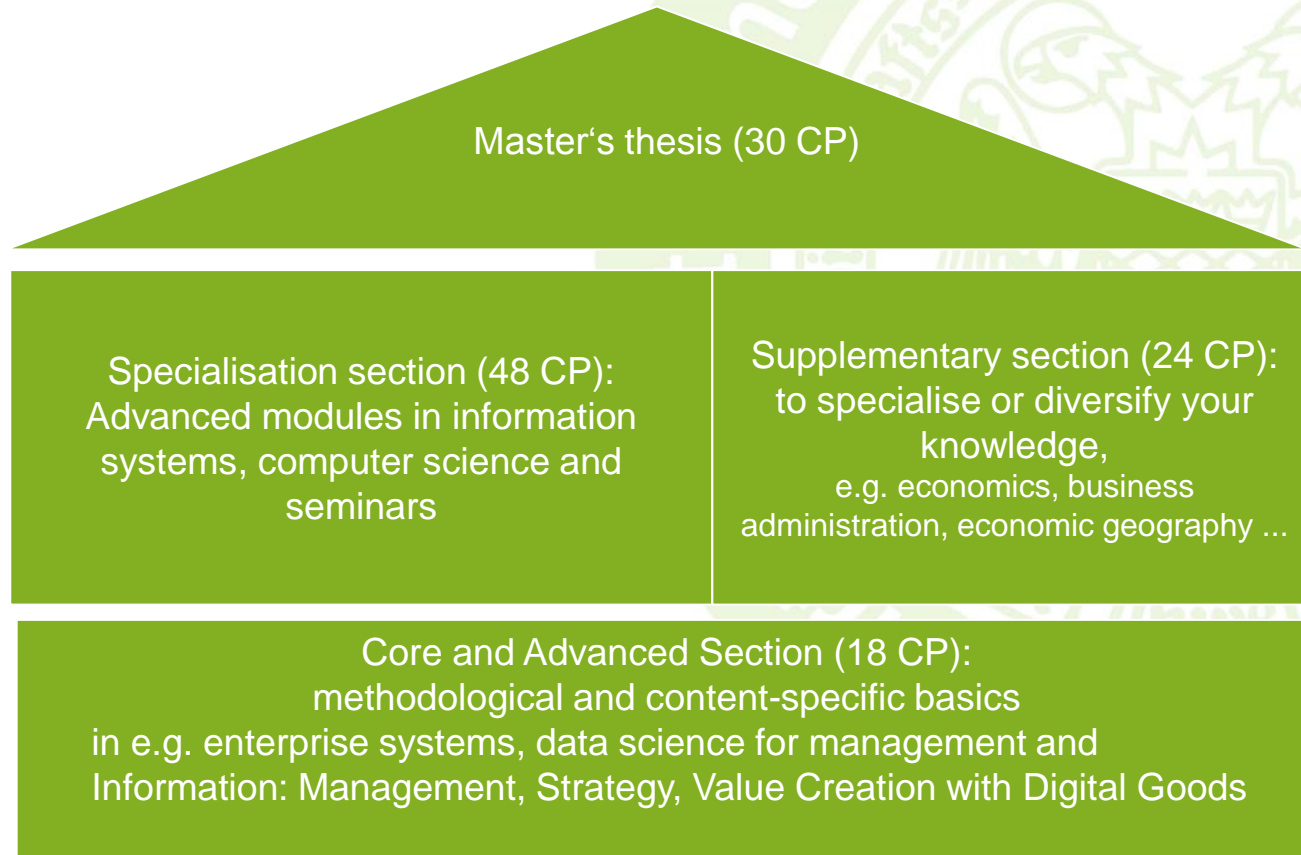
- provides the theoretical and methodological tools for dealing with key issues such as

# Admission requirements

- Bachelor's degree (finished or at least earned 80% of the required degree CP)
- Overall grade of at least 2.7 (German grade)
- At least 20 CP credits in information systems
- At least 30 CP in business administration and economics
- At least 30 CP in informatics and/or mathematics and/or statistics

## Language requirements

- English level B2, e.g. TOEFL 87 ibt; German DSH-2 or DSH-3



# Selection criteria for Health Economics (not DMP)

Bachelor grade  
(1,0 - 2,7 German  
grade system)

Last year's  
score: 2,1

- The procedure is based on the grade earned in the Bachelor's degree or a course of study deemed equivalent
- If the number of applicants meeting the admission criteria exceeds the number of places available for this course of study, a selection procedure is initiated for the purpose of ranking these applicants
